

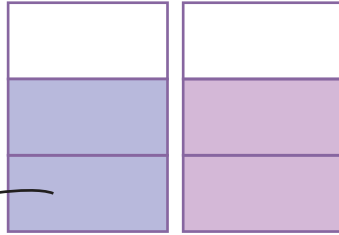


Multiplying Fractions



$$\frac{2}{3} \times 2 =$$

$$\frac{1}{3}$$



$$(2 \times 2) \text{ times } \frac{1}{3} \text{ is } \frac{4}{3}$$

$$\frac{2}{3} \times 2 = \frac{4}{3}$$

$$\frac{4}{3} = 1 \frac{1}{3}$$
